2.1 Regarding Jyotiraditya Institute of Pharmacy, Uttar Pradesh (PCI-4204)

1. The latest information on record including Order dt. 19.9.2025 in W.P.(C) 13928/2025 & CM APPL. 57002/2025 in r/o Jyotiraditya Institute of Pharmacy, Uttar Pradesh was placed and considered.
2. It was noted that the Council has conducted inspection on 27.3.2025 for existing courses i.e. D.Pharm and B.Pharm course not for introduction of New course i.e. M.Pharm, Pharm.D & Pharm.D(P.B.) Course. As there is common SIF hence all courses reflected during inspection
3. In view of above, it was decided as under –
 - a) that there is no sufficient time left for council to process and to take final decision on application of the institution for introduction of new M.Pharm (Pharmacology), M.Pharm (Pharmaceutical Chemistry), M.Pharm (Pharmacognosy), M.Pharm (Pharmaceutics), Pharm.D & Pharm.D (PB) courses.
 - b) to reject the application of this college in respect of introduction of new courses for academic session 2025-2026 due to non-submission of statutory documents. Further, the Council will refund the PERC charges for those courses which have not considered by the Council in 2025-2026 academic session as per decision of 431st Executive Committee (18.9.2025).

- c) Further, it is informed that the PCI Portal has opened from 06.10.2025 to 31.10.2025 for the 2026-2027 academic session. If the institution wishes to apply with complete documents, the Council will consider the application.

2.2 Regarding Anjali College of Pharmacy and Science (PCI-104)

1. The latest information on record including Order dt.19.9.2025 in W.P.(C) 6012/2025 & CM APPL. 27523/2025 and order dt. 23.9.2025 in CM APPL. 60704/2025 (by petitioner under Section 151 CPC seeking modification of order dated 19.09.2025 passed by Hon'ble Delhi High Court in respect of Anjali College of Pharmacy and Science was placed and considered.
