फार्मैसी काउन्सिल आफ इण्डिया से निर्गत एप्रूवल लेटर के क्रम में संस्थान में उपलब्ध अवस्थापना सुविधा एवं मानव संसाधन के सत्यापन हेतु विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा निरीक्षण समिति का गठन किया गया। निरीक्षण समिति की रिपोर्ट दिनांक 15.11.2025 को प्राप्त हुयी है जिसमें समिति द्वारा संस्थान को **Recommended** किया गया है।

उल्लेखनीय है कि शैक्षिक सत्र 2025-26 के लिए मा0 उच्चतम न्यायालय द्वारा अन्तिम तिथि दिनांक 15.11.2025 निर्धारित होने के कारण निरीक्षण समिति की रिपोर्ट को विश्वविद्यालय की सम्बद्धता समिति में प्रस्तुत करना, सम्बद्धता समिति की संस्तुति पर शासन का अनुमोदन प्राप्त करना तथा शासन से प्राप्त अनुमोदन के क्रम में प्रवेश की कार्यवाही किया जाना समयबद्धता के दृष्टिगत पुरा किया जाना सम्भव नहीं हो सका।

उक्त के सम्बन्ध में मुझे यह कहने का निदेश हुआ है कि संस्थान को पी0सी0आई0 से सत्र 2026-27 में उपरोक्त पाठ्यक्रम व प्रवेश क्षमता का एप्रूवल पत्र प्राप्त होने के क्रम में निरीक्षण समिति की उक्त संस्तुति एवं शासनादेश दिनांक 31.10.2025 में वर्णित व्यवस्था के आलोक में सम्बद्धता समिति की संस्तुति शासन को आवश्यक कार्यवाही के लिए प्रेषित की जायेगी।

- b) ratify the action taken by PCI for not providing the edit option to the institutions for additional courses i.e Pharm.D and M.Pharm course in the PCI portal as institutions has failed to submit consent of Examining Authority for 2025-2026 academic session for introduction of new M.Pharm and Pharm.D course approved by PCI.
- c) file the application in the court for non compliance of the court order by the institution and AKTU for withdrawal of the approval of Pharm.D and M.Pharm course.
