- 14.1 The latest information on record including Order dt. 04.02.2026 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Kalaburagi Bench and advocate mail dt. 11.02.2026 was placed and considered.

14.2 It was noted that EC observed following deficiencies -

Inspection team has informed that—

Inspected the college as per PCI order we found no college building at the address. However principal informed college is shifted to another location without permission from PCI. The inspection was continued in the new address except principal No other requirement as per PCI norms were found Not available. The college currently working at Gautham College of Nursing Labs classrooms and other infrastructure and even staff Not available. Videos Photographic evidence will be mailed to PCI registrar.

The Gulbarga college of Pharmacy (PCI 4095) new working address is at Goutam college of Nursing. The inspection was continued at the new address given by principal of Gulbarga College of pharmacy Gulbarga. Except principal all other staff was not available, complete infrastructure was of Nursing College, we didn't find any pharmacy related classrooms, Laboratory, Administrative Office, Machine room, Library, Girls and Boys common room and other infrastructure. Principal even don't have land, building, Government order type of documentary evidence.

14.3 In view of above, EC recommended to Central Council for withdrawal of approval of institution.

14.4 It was also decided to arrange inspection as per mail dt.11.02.2026 received from advocate Mr. Sanjeev Patil in respect of 22 institutions where Hon'ble Court has given oral order dt.04.02.2026 for inspection of institution.

14.5 It was further decided to take action in anticipation of comments from the EC members on the EC minutes.

- i) As per list received from Karnataka Drugs Control Department for joint inspection was 32 institutions, out of which only 25 institutions have applied to the PCI during 2026-2027 academic session. Out of 25 where panels required, only 23 panels were received, in respect of two institutions panels not received.
 - a) Sri Sai College of Pharmacy, PCI-952
 - b) Royal College of Pharmacy, PCI-3768
- ii) Remaining 10 institutions (out of 35) –
 - a) One ID was duplicate. (PCI ID- 2340)
 - b) In respect of 04 cases, inspection already arranged for 2026-2027 academic sessions and above 04 cases were not available in the list received from Karnataka Drugs Control Department. (PCI-5402, PCI-9169, PCI-3071, PCI-4421).
- iii) 4 were not available in the list of Karnataka Drugs Control Department. (PCI-3678, PCI-4099, PCI-2341, PCI-3248).

15.3 In view of above, it was decided to arrange joint inspection in respect of those institutions where list received from Drug Control Department, Karnataka.

15.4 It was also decided to ratify the action taken by the council office regarding nominating Dr. Saleemulla Khan, Member, PCI as a coordinator in joint inspection with PCI and Drug Controller Department of Karnataka.
