02.442.006: Consideration of inspection reports dt.16.2.2026 of Kohinoor Education Society's Kohinoor Institute of Pharmacy, Maharashtra /PCI- 4040. Conducted to verify complaint.

6.1 The latest information on record was placed and considered.

6.2 It was noted that -

- a) Council received complaint from Government of Maharashtra Education department against Kohinoor Education Society's Kohinoor Institute of Pharmacy regarding lack of infrastructure, teaching staff and other facilities.
- b) Joint inspection was arranged by PCI along with Government of Maharashtra, Babasaheb Ambedkar Technological Lonere and MSBT, Mumbai.
- c) Inspection report reveals following deficiencies:

1. *The D.Pharm program started in 2019 and the B.Pharm program started in 2021.*
2. *The approval of MSBTE, Mumbai and BATU, Lonere is not-available for session 2024-2025 and hence no admission for this session.*
3. *The building occupation certificate is not-available since the building is incomplete as on date. The first floor construction is complete. The 1st floor of the building is under construction with column being ready.*
4. *The complaint as per the Annexure-I i.e., that the premises of Kohinoor Arts, Commerce, Science college being used in showing basic by the Kohinoor institute of Pharmacy can't be verified as the entry to the Kohinoor Arts, Commerce, Science college running the same campus was restricted to the inspection team members and not-allowed to enter the premises by the In-charge Principal.*
5. *The next complaint as mentioned in the Annexure-I i.e., the new building is of Kohinoor Institute of pharmacy wherein the major infrastructure area, facilities, amenities, equipment etc is not-available.*
6. *Deficiencies noted by the inspection team are as follows:-*
 - i. *Website of institute not-available*
 - ii) *Occupancy certificate not-available*
 - iii) *Resolution made by society/ trust/ management not-available with the institution*
 - iv) *Principal +25 teaching staff required was not-available at the institution.*
 - v) *Non-teaching staff only 03 nos. of Non-teaching staff was available.*
 - vi) *11 No. of laboratories not-available at the institution, remaining 02 labs available were not furnished.*
 - vii) *04 No. of classroom deficient.*
 - viii) *Common facilities such as, machine room, central instrumentation room, library, computer room (not furnished), Boy's common room seminar hall museum, balance room, store room I & II, first aid room not-available, girls common room are not available.*
 - ix) *Herbal garden not-available*
 - x) *Library documents such as purchase bills, accessories register, books, journals etc., not-available in the institution.*

xi) Financial documents such as.

- Audited financial statement.*
- Latest projected budget and expenditure*
- Details of salary disbursement bank transaction details.*

Not available at the institution.

xii) Pay scale teaching and non-teaching as per UGC/AICTE/State Government norms not given to staff.

xiii) Salary acquaintances register of staff not-available.

xiv) Occupancy certificate for municipal corporation is not available. The building is to complete upto ground floor.

xvi) Post of the Principal is vacant for more than 2 years.

xvii) Principal is not available in the institute.

xviii) Three faculty are not eligible as per PCI norms As they have passed their B.Pharm qualification in the year 2024.

xix) Three faculty were appointed on the day of inspection only. Out of which 2 were present and 1 absent.

xx) 26 faculty are deficient.

xxi) As per new regulations lab attendant for D.Pharm and B.Pharm required are 10. However only 2 were employed.

xxii) Library with books and all items are not available at the institution on the day of inspection.

xxiii) The purchase bills of library infrastructures, books, journals, IP etc. couldn't verify as they were not available at the institution.

- 6.3 In view of above, it was decided to recommend to the Central Council to issue notice for withdrawal of approval u/s 13 of the Pharmacy Act.
- 6.4 It was also decided to circulate the same to the Central Council.
- 6.5 It was further decided to take action in anticipation of comments from the EC members on the EC minutes.
