The matter was threadbarley discussed. It was noted that PCI vide circular dt.17.7.2019 has imposed moratorium on opening of new D.Pharm and B.Pharm institutions for a period of 5 years from 2020-2021 academic session. In view of it, the institutions which have failed to maintain the approval of PCI i.e. there is a break in the approval in terms of no admissions, such institutions be considered as new institutions covered under Council's moratorium and not to consider for approval.

In view of above, the following Resolution was unanimously taken –

Resolution

In the light of Council's moratorium dt.17.7.2019, the Central Council unanimously resolved that the institutions that have failed to maintain the approval of PCI and /or have been closed with no admissions (with or without intimation to PCI) will be viewed as new institutions and treated as such.

- d) From 2020-2021 academic session PCI imposed moratorium in the states where Pharmacy institutions are more than 50.
- e) Institution continuously applying to the PCI since 2020-2021 academic session and submitting consent of affiliation of examining authority dated 26.02.2016 which was valid upto two years from date of issuance.
