Matter was placed before 447th EC under item no.36 where EC decided to seek Standard Inspection Form (SIF) under Section 12(3) of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 from those institutions who did not apply for 2026-27 academic session, without PERC.
- d) Accordingly, PCI has opened the portal between 10.07.2026 to 27.07.2026.

13.3 In view of above it was decided to -

- a) assign inspection in respect of remaining pending institutions and authorize the President to give panel of inspectors.
- b) also arrange inspection wherever institutions have submitted Standard Inspection Form (SIF) under Section 12(3) of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 without PERC and inspection cost and TA/DA of inspectors shall be borne by institutions.

 - b) In pursuance of the above decision, the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) implemented the decision and informed the respective institutions where the above faculty members were serving.
 - c) Subsequently, PCI has received representations from the above inspectors/faculty members requesting revocation of the aforesaid decision, stating that they are facing severe hardship in earning their livelihood due to the debarment.
- 20.3 In view of above, the EC decided to revoke the restriction on their teaching positions in respect of all the above faculty members. However, the decision to block them from undertaking PCI inspection work for the stipulated period of two years shall remain unchanged.
