32.2 It was observed that Dr. R. K. Chouksey was shown as the Principal of SLS College of Pharmacy, Sagar, Madhya Pradesh. It was further observed that his name was reflected in multiple institutions against different positions, purportedly on the basis of forged documents, across the country. A list of such institutions is enclosed as **Annexure-13**. Accordingly, a surprise inspection was arranged to verify the facts. During the inspection, Dr. R. K. Chouksey was found absent from the other institutions where his name was reflected.

32.3 It was also observed that certain other faculty members were reflected in multiple institutions against different positions, purportedly on the basis of forged documents, across the country. A list of such faculty members is enclosed as **Annexure-14**.

32.4 In view of the above, it was decided to call the Principal/HOD of the concerned institution, along with the faculty members found to be working at more than one institution, before the PHC of PCI, along with the concerned inspectors, through online mode for verification and further necessary action.
