Sub: Submission of details for Nodal officer for each institution with regards to the disbursement of Pradhan Maniri Scholarship for Pharmacy Post Graduate Studies (GPAT)- (PMSPPS) and AEBAS Portal.

Sir/Madam,

This is to inform to all concerned that the Council has received multiple grievances and queries regarding the creation and updating of Nodal Officer credentials (Maker and Checker) on the GPAT portal, as well as on the AEBAS portal.

In order to streamline the process and ensure authenticated data collection, thereby avoiding any discrepancies or data leakage, I am directed to inform that, the Council has enabled dedicated services on the Digi-Pharmed portal. Institutions can now apply for the creation or change of Nodal Officer details for the GPAT Scholarship portal (including both Maker and Checker). Additionally, a similar service has been made available under the **Services** section for the creation or change of Nodal Officer details on the AEBAS platform.

All institutions are hereby requested to visit the Digi-Pharmed portal

(<https://digipharmed.pci.gov.in/#/digipharmed>), navigate to the **Services** section on the left-hand side, and apply for the relevant service, namely:

- Creation or change of Nodal Officer details for the GPAT Scholarship portal (including Maker and Checker), and/or
- Change of Nodal Officer details for the AEBAS Portal.

Kindly ensure that the registered email ID and mobile number are under the direct control of the institution to avoid frequent changes and any potential inconvenience in the future.

Institutions are advised to route all such requests exclusively through the portal going forward. No requests submitted via email will be entertained.

Further, all grievances are to be routed exclusively through the PCI online grievance portal (<https://digipharmed.pci.gov.in/#/login-issue>) via your valid student ID. Requests or concerns submitted via email will not be entertained.
