Warm greetings from the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI).

The Pharmacy Council of India is organizing the statewide celebration of **World Pharmacist Day / National Pharmacy Week 2026**.

The Theme of World Pharmacist Day 2026 is” **Empowering Pharmacists for Healthier Futures**” The Pharmacy Council of India is organising the celebration under the overarching mission of "**Swastha Bharat: Combating Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR)**". This initiative aims to promote awareness about AMR in pharmacy students and citizens of state; position pharmacists as central stewards, educators, and public health partners in promoting rational antimicrobial use, infection prevention, and patient safety across the nation.

To ensure a seamless, high-impact execution, the celebration is structured into two interconnected tiers:

State-Level Mega Event: A centralized single-day convention bringing together over 1,200 participants (students of D.Pharm, B.Pharm, M.Pharm, Pharm.D, and Ph.D.) featuring scientific competitions (Poster, Scitoon, Pharma-Quiz), digital events (Reel making, Leaflets making), an Awareness Rally, and a Multi-stakeholder Panel Discussion.

Institute-Level Outreach Week: Simultaneous campus and community-driven AMR campaigns across all institutions.

The designated host institution will be responsible for anchoring the state-level mega event on behalf of PCI. A core mandate of this event is **inter-institutional collaboration across the state**. The host institute must actively coordinate with other Pharmacy Institutions in the region and induct Faculty Members from different colleges into the various organizing committees.

Institutions possessing the requisite infrastructural capacity—including an auditorium for 1,200+ delegates, breakout zones for parallel competitions, dining facilities, emergency

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safeguards, and proven event-handling track records—**are invited to submit their Expression of Interest.**
