The Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) is organizing the Statewide Celebration of World Pharmacists Day / National Pharmacy Week 2026 on the theme:

“Empowering Pharmacists for Healthier Futures”

and sub theme :

“Swastha Bharat: Combating Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR)”.

In this regard, all pharmacy institutions are requested to actively participate in the celebration and organize various activities at the institutional level, including -

1. Awareness Rally
2. Panel Discussion Competitions:
3. Poster Presentation
4. Scitoons
5. Pharma-Quiz
6. Reel making competitions
7. Leaflet making competitions
8. Street play (Nukkad Natak)

The above activities may be conducted at the institutional level, with active participation of students and faculty members, with the objective of creating

awareness about the pharmacy profession and highlighting the vital role of pharmacists in promoting healthier communities.

Institution has to appoint a nodal officer, who will coordinate the conduct of institute level events and registration of winners for state level event. He shall accompany students on the day of event. Institution will arrange competitions in each event and finalize the winners and submit their nominations for participation at state level event through the nodal officer. Institutions shall provide all necessary support to the nodal officer in coordinating the event at institution level and at state level.

Further, a State-Level Programme will be organized as a one-day event, wherein the above-mentioned competitions/activities will be conducted.

All pharmacy institutions shall actively participate in the celebration and contribute towards making the event a meaningful and impactful initiative for the advancement of the pharmacy profession and the benefit of pharmacy students.

Further, in continuation to Council's circulars regarding nomination of one Nodal Officer from each institution for coordination of the activities related to the celebration of World Pharmacists Day / National Pharmacy Week 2026, the last date for submission of the details has been extended up to 17 September 2026.

The institutions shall nominate their Nodal Officer at the earliest and submit the requisite details through the Google Form available at the link given below:
