Sir/Madam,

This is in reference to the previous circulars issued by the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), wherein the Council has reiterated, on multiple occasions, the requirement for implementation of AEBAS in Pharmacy Institutions, Updation of documents in their profile and the prescribed procedure for marking attendance of pharmacy faculty through AEBAS.

In this regard, all Teaching Pharmacists having a BH-P Number

registered on the DIGI-PHARMed Portal are hereby directed to ensure that their profiles are complete, accurate and supported by valid and authentic documents across all applicable sections of the portal.

Based on the scrutiny of the council, it has again come into the notice that there are numerous profiles which are intentionally being created fake with similar educational documents, SPC certificates, similar name etc. These actions are fraudulent in nature and council may initiate the further legal action for undergoing such action despite of multiple directions via various circulars.

Accordingly, the Council hereby reiterates, for the last time, that all BH-P profiles having such irregularities and/or pending verification shall complete the required authentication and profile-completion process within 7 (seven) days from the date of issuance of this notice.

Further, as the Health Professional Registry (HPR) registration/verification process is now live, all existing pharmacists having a BH-P profile and are required to log in to the concerned portal and complete the applicable HPR verification process as well.

The Council shall undertake a comprehensive scrutiny of the profiles and the following requirements shall be treated as mandatory:

1. AEBAS Verification: Faculty members who are required to mark attendance through AEBAS must have their AEBAS verification duly completed on their respective institutions AEBAS System.
2. e-KYC: The required e-KYC/authentication process must be completed successfully if applicable.
3. Educational Qualifications: All educational certificates uploaded on the DIGI-PHARMed Portal must be genuine, valid and verifiable. If not updated, the same must be kept up to date during the completion of HPR Profile.
4. State Pharmacy Council Registration: The registration details and certificates must be authentic, valid and duly verifiable. No duplicity or usage of documents from other individuals are allowed in this.

5. Supporting Documents: All other documents uploaded against the profile must be genuine, relevant, valid and consistent with the information furnished by the pharmacist.

6. Profile Authenticity: No duplicate, fictitious, misleading or otherwise fraudulent profile shall be created or used for representing faculty in any pharmacy institution.

If profiles identified with irregularities or pending mandatory verification may be placed under the debarred/non-compliant category and shall not be treated as valid faculty profiles for the concerned institution until the prescribed verification and compliance requirements are duly completed. If the status remains the same, council will further proceed for the de-activation of the profile registered on Digi-Pharmed Portal.

Subsequently, if any pharmacist is found to be non-compliant, including cases where the profile does not have the required AEBAS verification (where applicable), e-KYC or HPR verification, or where the educational qualifications, State Pharmacy Council registration or other supporting documents are found to be incomplete, invalid, fabricated, duplicated or otherwise unauthentic, the Council may take appropriate action against the concerned individual and/or institution.

The Council further reiterates that any attempt to create, maintain or use duplicate/fictitious profiles or fake faculty credentials shall be viewed seriously and may result in strict legal and disciplinary action under the applicable provisions of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, Information Technology Act, 2000, and other applicable laws/rules/regulations, as deemed appropriate for the council.

All concerned are therefore advised to treat this notice as urgent and final and ensure compliance within the stipulated period to avoid adverse action.
